



After-Accident Checklist & Procedures

• Immediate Actions (Safety First):

- Stop the aircraft safely if still in motion.
- Ensure the safety of all passengers and yourself.
- Check for injuries and call emergency services (911) if necessary.
- Shut down the engine and activate hazard lights/beacon.
- Do not admit fault to other parties; let the investigation proceed.

• Documentation & Reporting:

- Take photos of the aircraft damage, location, and any other relevant factors.
- Gather information from witnesses, if any.
- Report the accident to the FAA and NTSB as required by regulation.
- **Contact Avemco Insurance** immediately to report the claim. 24/7 Claims service is available at **800-874-9124**.

• Claims Process (Avemco Specifics):

- **Total Loss Protocol:** If the cost of transport and repairs exceeds 70% of the insured value, it may be considered a total loss, and Avemco will retain the salvage.
- **Retaining Salvage:** If you wish to keep the salvage, inform your claims adjuster immediately.
- **Documentation:** Prepare to provide a detailed account of the incident to your adjuster.

• Post-Incident:

- Follow instructions from your Avemco adjuster regarding repairs or aircraft inspection.
